

ARCHERY BASIC (LEVEL I) INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION TRAINING

DATE: Saturday – January 19, 2013

The Basic Certification course will teach you to be a safe and effective instructor. The course introduces how to teach archery. It focuses on safety, range set-up, basic equipment setup and repair and teaching the basic steps of shooting. Each student will receive a packet with the basic book, all required paperwork and a 3-year certification.

This certification is suggested for any adult leader who would like to take his Troop or Crew to shoot archery, but is also open to any youth who are ages 16 and up as a basic course that would allow them to assist and help at Day Camp or Resident Camp (it is suggested they add the Cub Scout Shooting course in May if this is their plan) or at Napowan's Archery range (after additional training from a NCS Shooting Sports Director). This certification could also allow you to work with a park district archery program, Archery in the Schools Program, Archery after School Program, or with Girl Scouts or American Heritage Girls.

The course lasts about 10 hours with a one hour lunch break, and will take you through learning to shoot as if you had never held a bow in your hands before. In this way it helps you to become a better instructor for the Scouts.
