



SUMMER CAMP SHOOTING SPORTS STAFF TRAINING

Archery and BB gun range staff for Day Camp and Resident Camp, Day and Resident Camp Program Directors, Napowan Shooting Sports Staff and Program Directors need to attend the training at Camp Lakota on May 19, 2013. ***Training will start at 9:00 a.m. and will end APPROXIMATELY at 4:00 p.m. Participants will need to bring their own sack lunch and water bottles and dress for the weather, since the training will continue no matter what the day is like. Each Range officer will need to have his or her own whistle.***

For the BB and Archery Ranges at Day and Resident Camps the Range Officers must be 18 or older. Any youth staff they may have to assist them should also attend, so everyone is trained the same way at the same time. For Napowan, the Archery instructor must be over 18 and the Shotgun and Rifle Instructors over 21 and hold NRA Instructor and RSO certification and at least one must have National Camp School training. Youth staff should also attend.

We will learn how to use the new equipment from our grants in this session.
