Wilderness and Remote First Aid

April 14 - 15, 2012 at Camp Lakota

We are offering the American Red Cross Wilderness and Remote First Aid Course. It has been developed in conjunction with the BSA and is based on the 2010 BSA Wilderness First Aid Curriculum and Doctrine Guidelines. This is THE course for those who work, live, or play in remote areas - away from the usual EMS service. Philmont requires that at least one person (preferably two) in each crew is certified in Wilderness and Remote First Aid. Please plan ahead!

This sixteen-hour course uses a combination of classroom, skills practice, and role-play in scenarios to teach the response steps and treatment of injuries and illnesses in a delayed-help situation. The class covers assessment and first aid techniques, preparing you to act in an emergency in any high adventure situation.

The course will take place at Camp Lakota, Woodstock, Illinois. It will begin with arrival at Camp Lakota at 8:00 a.m., Saturday, April 14, 2012 and end at approximately 4:00 p.m. Sunday, April 15, 2012. The cost for the course is \$100.00 for the weekend which includes all meals, one night of camping (not a course requirement), and course materials. Course materials include an Emergency Reference Guide structured around the course content and a weather resistant pocket guide for easy access on outings.

Course pre-requisites: You **MUST** hold a current certification in Adult CPR/AED on the date of the course. Participants must also be a minimum of 14 years of age. These are Red Cross requirements - no exceptions. No re-certifications are possible with this course.

Successful completion of the course requires that the participant attend all class sessions, participate in all skill sessions and activities, demonstrate competency in all observable skills, and complete the scenarios. Certification is valid for 2 years.

Registration is limited to the first thirty-six paid registrants. Once materials are ordered, no refunds will be made, however substitutions made in advance will be allowed.

Deadline for registration is March 8, 2012

A minimum of twelve participants is needed to run the course
