Most Camp programs are based on a boy's Cub Scout Rank. Many of the activities that are fun provide opportunities to qualify toward rank advancements, electives and belt loops. BEAR WHITTILING

ALL Bear Scouts will be given an opportunity to earn their Whittling Chip during our Scout Skills rotation.

Permission Slips ARE REQUIRED in ADVANCE – WITH REGISTRATION in order to participate. See attached form for completion if this applies to your scout.

WEBELOS - AQUANAUT

ALL Webelos (who have not already earned Aquanaut) will be given the option to participate and earn the Aquanaut Pin during our Swimming Session at Barrington Aqualusion Water Park on Thursday, June 21st.

NO permission slip is required, however, participants MUST sign up no later than Wednesday, June 20th to participate.

What TO Bring to DAY Camp

Medications

- Any required medication must be checked in with the Health Officer upon arrival to camp. All medications must be in the original container, marked clearly with the patient's name and dosage and be noted on the health forms.
NO EXCEPTIONS.

What NOT TO Bring

- Sandals, swim shoes, crocs or Heelys
- Radios (AM/FM and/or two-way)
- Knives
- Cell Phones or other hand held electronics (iPods, DSI/Gameboys, CD Players, cell phones, etc.)
- Valuables
- Glass items
- Non-prescription drugs

STAFF

Signal Hill Day Camp Staff is made up of individuals, parents and leaders, who VOLUNTEER their time to meet, plan and execute a productive, fun and educational program for YOUR scout.

RANGERS

Both BB and Archery Rangers have been trained and certified by NWSC certified staff in safety, skill and execution in order to provide your scout with proper instruction and education in accordance with BSA guidelines.

DIRECTOR

Your Day Camp Director has been trained and certified to run this BSA Accredited Day Camp which complies with the rules, regulations and guidelines set forth by BSA.

Pack Provided Chaperones

CHAPERONES- LEADERSHIP ~ RATIO 1:5

EACH PACK is required to provide its own chaperones/leadership through parents and leaders. National BSA policy requires two-deep adult leadership. When you volunteer to be a chaperone, you will be asked to oversee, guide and assist staff/rangers/director by offering hands on assistance and guidance to groups of Scouts throughout day camp.

Transportation

You are expected to provide your own transportation. We ask that you do your best to arrive at camp on time. This will help expedite the check-in process and allow the staff to begin the day's activities promptly as scheduled.

Health Form A & B

The Boy Scouts of American Medical Form #34605 Parts A and B is required for ALL campers (**youth and adults**) attending day camp. This form does NOT need to be completed by a physician.

Please attach a copy of insurance card, both front and back to the form.

ALL chaperones are required to have the same form on file at the time of registration.

Registration will NOT be secured if Health Forms A & B are not included with your registration packet, meaning that your scouts place will not be "saved", thus registration will not be secured until Camp Director has received all required documentation.

It is **requested and HIGHLY** recommended that all registration be COMPLETE, including these forms, before forwarding to Council.

Scouts will NOT be permitted to attend camp if this information is not on file.

Camp Director and/or Staff will NOT be responsible for tracking down and/or reminding parent, leaders or units of missing documentation.

Day Camp Capacity is 125 Registered Campers

There are NO holding places for campers – all registration is first come first served – DON'T DELAY!

Deadline & Guidelines

COMPLETE REGISTRATION IS DUE TO COUNCIL OFFICE BY 4 PM on May 15th for standard registration. Council office will NOT accept any registrations after that time. Late registration must be delivered directly to the Day Camp Director and are subject to program availability.

Postmark dates, incomplete forms or “payment to follow” will not be accepted. **COMPLETE Registration includes completed and signed Cub Scout Registration Form, completed and signed with Health and Medical Form #34605 Parts A & B, and payment in full.** If camper registration is NOT complete when received, camper will NOT secure a place on our Day Camp Roster until all documents/payments are secured. In the event that incomplete registration is received camper documents will be held, when completed camper will be assigned a spot on our roster provided space remains. Payment alone DOES NOT HOLD YOUR SPOT.

NO WALK-IN REGISTRATIONS

NO SIBLINGS ALLOWED (unless attending as a qualifying “friend”)

***Qualifying friend/sibling = entering 1st thru 5th grades.**

Pack Registration

Pack registrations MUST include a list of boys’ names, ages, parents’ names, and phone numbers for each participant. Packs may pay by pack accounts or pack checks. Faxed registrations are acceptable if there are adequate funds in Pack account *with proper authorization*. **CALL AHEAD TO VERIFY ACCOUNT BALANCE.** Individuals must pay by cash or check. It is your responsibility to be sure faxed or mailed registrations reach the Council office by the deadline.

Individual Registration

A Cub Scout Camper may register individually, although Pack registration is preferred.

***Note – if Scout is registering individually he MUST be accompanied/chaperoned by an adult/parent. Be sure to complete the box provided in the Cub Information of the registration form if this applies to your scout.**
